

QUEENSLANDSCAPES by Brian HATCH

At the REDLAND MUSEUM ART GALLERY

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REDLAND MUSEUM INVITES YOU & YOUR FRIENDS TO VIEW THIS EXHIBITION OF PAINTINGS ON SHOW FROM THE OPENING ON 10th JUNE 11am TO THE END OF JULY.

These works show a wide variety of techniques Brian uses to explore the Queensland landscape. Oils and acrylics are the main mediums used along with watercolours and limited edition prints.

Also on show are a series of modern style 'scrimshaw' plates and prints similar to those used by sailors to while away the time at sea.

These imaginative seascapes and landscapes are inspired by Brian's travels around Queensland and the mini watercolours are created using a wet in wet technique.

The scrimshaw-style zinc plates are a result of a visit to Hawaii where engraved whale bones were on display and Brian realised there was a link with printmaking and scrimshaw. All works are for sale.
